## Coronavirus (COVID-19) catch-up premium

Children and young people across the country have experienced unprecedented disruption to their education as a result of coronavirus (COVID-19). Those from the most vulnerable and disadvantaged backgrounds will be among those hardest hit. The aggregate impact of lost time in education will be substantial, and the scale of our response must match the scale of the challenge.

The Government has allocated additional funding, the COVID catch-up premium to allow schools to address these challenges. Whilst all pupils will have been affected, this additional funding is particularly aimed at disadvantaged and vulnerable pupils who need extra support.

At Kings' School, we intend to deliver this support through a range of initiatives, including:

- Small group intervention
- One to one tutor sessions
- Additional welfare support building capacity in the pastoral team
- Additional resources (study guides, equipment) to assist learning
- Additional support for on-line learning

The impact of these interventions will be assessed by regular monitoring of individual pupil progress through the academic year.
