

Year 11 Boys Football Team beat Westgate 3-0 to go through to the District Cup Semi Final.




Girls KS4 Volleyball team won 1 out of 2 of their recent matches!

Year 9's and 10's Rugby Team will be playing in the county cup final!




## THE SPRING CONCERT! 23<sup>RD</sup> OF MARCH

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## MUSIC




- GCSE coursework is due in after half term for the Year 11 students, well done for working so hard
